- Compilation of three bills (AB1739, SB1168, SB1319)





Who is responsible for complying with SGMA?


- ➤ Local *Groundwater Sustainability*Agencies (GSAs) are responsible for preparing and implementing

 Groundwater Sustainability Plans (GSPs) to achieve sustainable groundwater management in their basins over a 20-year period
- ➤ Fillmore and Piru Basins GSA was formed to provide local control over SGMA compliance and management of the groundwater resources.

Why do we need to do this?



- Fillmore and Piru basins assigned **HIGH** priority by DWR
- ➤ Priority rating driven, at least in part, by dependence on groundwater
- ➤ If local management does not occur, State of CA can take over management of the basin.
- ➤ Groundwater resource sustainability is beneficial to all
